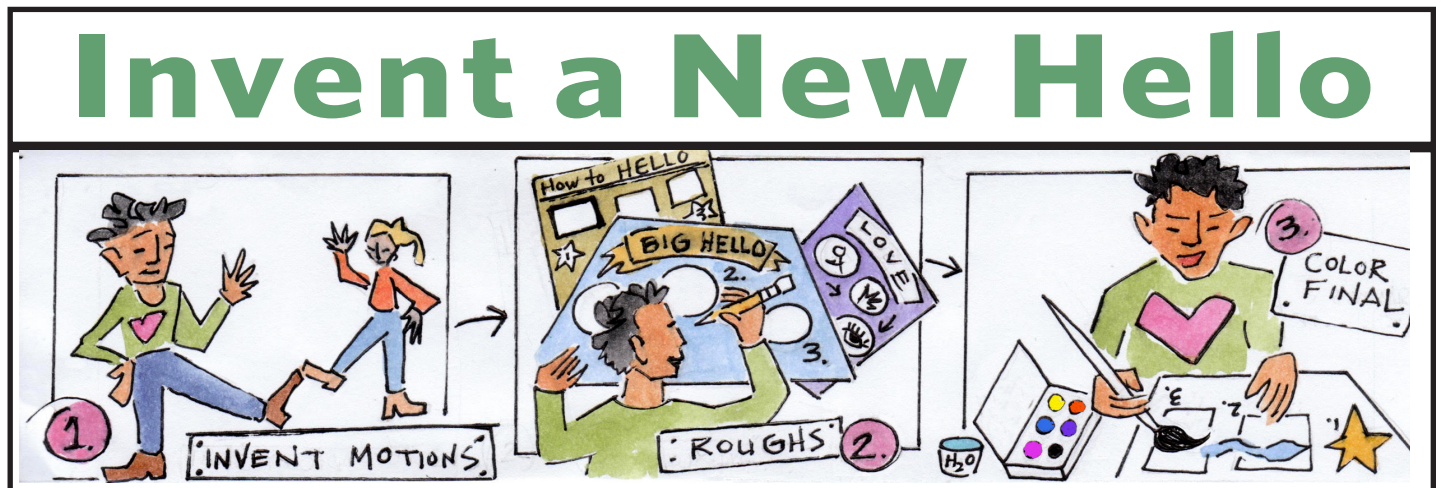


During this historic time of coronavirus pandemic, some humans miss saying hello to their friends or grandparents with traditional greetings like: hugging, handshakes, high-fives, or kissing on the cheek.

Your challenge today is to invent a NEW way that people can greet each other while keeping six feet apart while we need to take care of others. Will it involve hand motions, hips, fingers, or heads? Can it be adapted by people who are other-abled and maybe sitting?

After you figure out the motions, your illustrator job is to present the steps in an INFOGRAPHIC to teach other people the movements of your greeting.

An infographic is a way to share knowledge through pictures with minimal words.. You can design it in squares like a comic strip, perhaps in a flowing circle. It can have arrows, stars, or whatever you decide you need to share your information.



### Your Challenge:

**Make an Infographic to help people learn your new greeting.**

1. Invent your movements. Work as a team or on your own.
2. After you invent your movements, make a rough sketch of your infographic on scratch paper. Let your ideas change as you come up with better ones. Will you need any words? Numbers? A title?
3. On a final paper, sketch out and color your infographic.

Illustrator Hint: Sketch lightly!  
Then it is easier to make changes  
as you rough out your ideas.
